When you go to your doctor's

consultation, he/she will give you a Treatment Sheet where all the necessary medication is comprised along with the instructions for its proper administration. In your pharmacy, you will have to show your Treatment Sheet along with your medical card so that the medication which is still pending to be taken is dispensed to you. You will have to pay for the corresponding contribution. In case of deterioration or loss of your medical card, the only valid document will be the Treatment Sheet

Advantages

With this new system you will not have to go to your Medical Centre to get your prescriptions with your regular medication. In the pharmacy they will dispense you the necessary amount of medicines to cover for the treatment. Save time and avoid the use of paper prescriptions.

Use the medicines rationally and avoid self-medication. Should you have any doubt, please ask your doctor and/or pharmacist.

Digital prescription

What is the digital prescription?

It is a computerized system which allows the doctor to send the information about your treatments directly to the pharmacy.

With this new system the traditional prescriptions in paper will gradually disappear.





▶ Collection deadline

The medicines for serious treatments or the first prescription for chronic treatments will be dispensed to you at the pharmacy in a ten days deadline, as happens with the traditional prescription.

For the chronic treatments, you will be authorized to withdraw regularly your medication during the time which has been established by your doctor, with a maximum duration of one year.

Depending on the pattern which has been established or the size of the medicine you will have the right to be dispensed the medication from ten days before the medicine is finished until 90 days after it is finished.

If you do not withdraw your medication in a 90 days deadline from the set date, the prescription will be blocked and you will have to go to the doctor's consultation so that he/she authorizes anew the dispense of the medicines.

Frequently Asked Questions

What medication am I taking?

On the Treatment Sheet you will be given by your doctor all the necessary medication will be present, including the duration and the frequency of the treatment.

Must I go back to the Medical Centre when I need more medication?

If it is a chronic treatment you DO NOT have to come back to the doctor's. In the pharmacy they will dispense you the medication until the authorized date indicated by the doctor.

▶ To which pharmacies can I go?

You can go to any pharmacy at the Murcia Region.

► Can I get a relative medication?

Yes, but you have to show both the Treatment Sheet and the medical card of the patient.

What happens if I go on holidays outside the Murcia Region?

If you will need your medication during your holidays outside the Murcia Region you will have to go previously to your doctor's so that he/she provides the medication for your holidays.
