WARD RULES

So everything will run smoothly, we all need to comply with certain rules.

Some of them directly affect you or those accompanying you:

FOR YOUR SECURITY:

- •During your stay, we will give you two identity wristbands to wear. One has your details and the other your baby's. Wear them throughout your stay with us. If they get torn or damaged in any way, let the nurse know as soon as possible.
- •When you are going to get up for the first time or whenever you are instructed to do so by the nurse request their help.
- •The bedside table is for storing your personal belongings.
- •Give valuable items to your family. Staff will not be held responsible for them.
- •If you are going to be absent from the Ward, please notify the nurse.
- •If you need anything, please ring the bell at the head of the bed.
- •In the event of any irregularity or suggestion, please contact the Ward Manager or Supervisor.
- •Please leave the room as soon as possible once you have been discharged. Somebody else needs your bed.

HYGIENE:

- •Smoking is not allowed on the Hospital premises. Neither inside buildings nor outside.
- •Toilets and beds are only for the hospitalised patients. Other toilets are available for public use.
- •Do not bring food into the wards. The hospital provides that most suited to your needs.
- •Request visitors not to bring flowers while you are staying here. They may cause allergies and favour the transmission of infections.

COMPANION/VISITORS:

- •When you are going to be transferred to your room, we shall let your companion know so he/she may be there when you arrive.
- •You are allowed one companion in your room 24 hours a day.
- •During visiting hours, from one p.m. to ten p.m., two companions are allowed.
- •During admission you will be given two visitors passes for relatives. Please return them when you are discharged from hospital.
